

SCHOLARSHIP OFFER FOR A POSTDOCTORAL INTERNSHIP

We are seeking applications for a full-time postdoctoral internship to work on a study entitled *Care Trajectories and Ambulatory Care Sensitive Conditions* funded by the Canadian Institutes of Health Research (CIHR).

The candidate will work under the supervision of Pre Pasquale Roberge and Pre Catherine Hudon, and will be affiliated to the Faculty of Medicine and Health Sciences of the Université de Sherbrooke and the CHUS Research Center. The person selected for this postdoctoral internship will be involved in:

- 1- the identification of care trajectories (CT) and the perception of health among individuals with an anxiety disorder (P. Roberge) and/or among frequent users of health services (C. Hudon)
- 2- the identification of the individual, social and environmental determinants related to CT for these individuals, and the comparison of the observed health inequalities.

This position represents a unique opportunity to work in an interdisciplinary environment, working on population health and primary care health services.

APPLICANT REQUIREMENTS

- Doctorate in health sciences, public health, statistics or related fields obtained in the last five years, or thesis submitted.
- Excellent research skills, including scientific writing in English.
- Scientific publications in international journals.
- Excellent skills in multivariate and longitudinal analyses.
- Experience with the analysis of medico-administrative databases.

CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT

- Duration of the internship: one year full-time, starting in the fall of 2018, with a possibility of a one-year extension
- Salary for the first year: \$45,000 scholarship
- The intern must commit to submit scholarship applications to funding agencies for the 2nd year.
- Place of work: Health Campus, Université de Sherbrooke (3001, 12th Avenue North, Sherbrooke, Québec)
- The candidate selected for the position will have to register at the Université de Sherbrooke, and will benefit from the conditions described in its policy for hosting and supporting postdoctoral fellows.
- Occasional trips to Montreal will be required to conduct analyses at the Institut de la statistique du Québec's research data access center (CADRISQ).
- The intern will have to commit to publishing the results of his/her work.

- A motivation letter explaining the candidate's interest in the scholarship, research interests and objectives
- Curriculum vitae showing completed studies, publications, presentations, scholarships and distinctions obtained.
